

Facebook Project – Speak by Laurie Halse Anderson

Directions:

Create a Facebook profile page for a character from the novel. You may create this on the computer or draw it on a piece of white paper. The following criteria must be included on the Facebook page:

1. Name of character and profile picture
2. Bio information of the character located under the name
3. Current status of character
4. 5 different wall posts from other characters from the novel
5. 2 additional personal posts from your Facebook character
6. 5 Friends and pictures
7. Complete the attached dialectical journal. Attach it to your facebook project.

Instructions for Dialectical Journal:

Of the 7 quotes required for the Facebook page, you must use 5 quotes on the dialectical journal. Write the name of the character that is speaking. Write the quote in quotation marks. Include the page number where you find the quote. Write commentary regarding the quote.

Requirements of status and posts:

1. Each of the posts must include a character trait using quotes from the novel.
2. Each post must be relevant to the conversation occurring on the Facebook page. The conversation must flow and make sense.

Rubric for Facebook project:

30 points	Neatly done – eye popping! You are applying what you’ve learned from appraising and evaluating projects
5 points	Profile pic & name
5 points	Bio information
5 points	Character status; status must reveal character trait and include quote from novel (1 quote from book)
5 points	5 friends and pictures
20 points	5 posts from other characters; posts must reveal character traits and include quotes from novel (5 quotes from book)
10 points	2 personal posts (your character); posts must reveal character trait and include quotes from novel (2 quotes from book)
10 points	Dialectical journal completed and attached
10 points	Conventions (capitalization, usage of grammar rules, punctuation, spelling)

Things not to do:

1. Use texting language – everything must be spelled correctly!
2. Procrastinate
3. Turn in late
